It's very different looking at dogs from the ring side, some I really admired.

Quite different when you go over them.

All had lovely temperaments, some mouths not 100% and I forgave one or two, slightly out.

Generally we are heading in the right direction one notable concern how many were round in eye!!

Others Pale in Tan & lacking tan face markings .

Movement also a concern some quite narrow behind others pinning in front.

Size also seems quite varied.

As breeders we are responsible for this vulnerable native breed.

Choosing the best sire and Dams for producing as near to our standard.

MPD (2) 1. Clementz & Gauthier, Madame & Madame A Woodstock 69 Joe Cocker de l'Etang de Pincemaille (atc bc83676fra) Just 6 month old Happy chappy, who was really enjoying his trip out! Well-marked with good tan markings, correct head and ear placement, Had good dark almond eye. Excellent top line which was held on the move. His movement was brisk & purposeful. He was almost too pretty for a male, did have some light undercoat showing through.

2. Iven Ms H. Sukelyas Henry Fenner, also a 6 month old, took him a while to settle on the move, nice top line & tail set, he had lovely tan, although lacked tan markings on face, which does detract from their expression. Nice pencil and thumb markings. He moved well once he settled, but at 6 months old plenty of time.

PD (4) 1. Hughes Mrs P F. Ribblespride Kruger. Good sized 9 month old, good bone and nice tight feet, lovely turn of stifle, ears could be more forward placed, but his good tan marking so this didn't detract from his expression, good shoulder placement going into good spring of rib. Tail just makes it in standard, moved and showed well.

2. Clementz & Gauthier, Madame & Madame A Woodstock 69 Joe Cocker de L'Etang de Pincemaille.

3. Jones Miss A D & Mrs D M. Mea Miracles Beorn Ragnar of Barleydust (imp fin)

YD (1) 1. Grant-Parkes Miss J Parabar Palanca's Prankster. Standing alone in this class, happy boy, topline excellent in profile did lose it slightly on the move. Correct dark almond eye, nice tight feet, balanced chap, correct shoulder.

PGD (5:1) 1. Homer Mr J. Barleydust Noel Fox Tipped eared boy, lovely expression perhaps a little round in eye, good working coat, topline and tail set excellent, neatest of feet, ribs could extend more, moved well.

2. Thomas Mr G & Mrs S. Skipest Winter Blues Strong 3 yr old male, Nice head and expression, quite pale in tan, good shoulder & spring of rib, excellent turn stifle, moved well when settled.

3. Lagonegro Mrs V & Mr L. Lankeela Kristi and Eeyore.

LD (1) 1. Cooper Dr E P J. Swanndale Walter Tybalt 3 yr old all male with nice dark eye & expressive ears, real working jacket, moved ok, tan could be darker, stood alone here.

OD (6) 1. Thwaite Mrs & Mrs E A Ch Ribblespride Crakemoor well up to size all male 6 yrs old, lovely eye & expression, correct head & ear placement. Moderate neck, well laid shoulders going into correct spring of rib, super topline held in profile and on the move. He's a model in profile, would prefer a darker tan & more flexion in front movement, A real worker pleased to give him DCC & BIS.

2. McBride Mrs W. Utthanshaven Wolf Moon Man, Pushed 1st all the way, lovely correct head & expression, best of top lines which he held in profile and on the move. nice dark eye, correct tan, good working jacket, nice tight feet. He just spoils himself doesn't just present himself, another day could well be reversed. RDCC, RBIS.

3. Grant-Parkes Miss J. Parabar Posy's Pawnee JW.

VD (5:3) 1. Munro Mrs K A. Ch Jorgei Cognac 11 yrs Liver & Tan All male with real substance, best of shoulders & top line his spring of rib 2nd to none! Still moving with real purpose, tad round in eye. A dog that could work all day. BVIS

2. Jones Mrs L. Ch Madincrowd Gabriel JW Another up to size male, correct head & ear set, front construction, topline standing and on the move all excellent. At 12 years old these boys could give the youngsters a run.

MPB (2.) 1 Webster Mrs K. Oreiphos Feed My Soul at Brockbrae 7 month well up to size, real working coat, good bone and feet. Ears rather soft not just a matching set, hopefully will firm up. nice topline falling away slightly at croup, moving confidently.

2. Preston Mrs S & Mr P. Piparlo Hugs and Kisses at Madelioli. Finely built 8 month old rather on the leg, head in proportion to her body, bite not correct, rather short coat, but is black throughout. Correct shoulder placement. Needs to settle on the move.

PB (3) 1. Grant-Parkes Miss J. Parabar Pelatory's Pichu. Lots to like about this young lady, filled the eye in profile, had the best working jacket today, correctly marked, good tan, nice tight feet, head & ear set correct, everything where it should be. moved well just a little close behind. BPIS

2. Webster Mrs K. Oreiphos Feed My Soul at Brockbrae.

3. Preston Mrs S & Mr P. Piparlo Hugs and Kisses at Madelioli.

JB (4:2) 1. Bellinger Mrs T. Foveaux Jean Genie at Heelstone well up to size, moving very well, correct bite, lovely dark eye, good reach neck, topline held in profile and moving, nice turn stifle, prefer a darker tan

2. Iven Ms H. Heffaklumpens Kors I Taket (atc bc44781swe) nice neat smaller bitch, good tan & markings, correct head ear set, shoulder well laid, nice tight feet, falls away slightly tail set, needs to concentrate on the move.

YB (5) 1. Thwaite Mr J & Mrs E A. Ribblespride Masquerade A lot to like here, a very well-balanced young lady, everything where it should be, best of top lines, super expression, enough bone for her size, shade longer in coat, cracking neat feet. Moved well. RCC.

2. Jones Miss A D & Mrs D M. Ch Barleydust Fancy Foxtrot, another cracker, appealing feminine lady almost 2 yrs. love this bitch never gone over her, tad short in muzzle, and round in eye. Correct tan markings & ear set, correct neck going into good shoulder placement, excellent topline neat on the move. could go either way with these two.

3. Clough & Erwin Mr I & Mrs J. Ribblespride Freya Fenrir

PGB (4) 1 Clementz & Gauthier, Madame & Madame. Foveaux Blues and Royals, very appealing neat 3yr old lady. super head and expression, neat tipped ears, correct colour and markings, I forgave her bite not quite correct, good topline she moved so well.

2. Bowker Mrs R & Mr C. Rosie Bouquet 2 yr liver & tan with excellent liver colour, tan could be darker. head correct proportions, nice shoulder good chest, good ribbing could extend more, good topline, neat feet, moving well.

3. Thwaite Mr J & Mrs E A. Tudorbrook Morgana.

LB (4) 1 Duffy Miss A V. Vittador Jean Lyons 20 months, look at me, real show girl, correct head excellent dark almond eye, forward placed ears of correct size, neck in proportion, best of shoulders, lovely top line nice tight feet. Definitely going somewhere on the move, to be super critical would like more tan on face. Pleased to give her BCC which I heard subject to KC make her a Champion, all under 3 breed judges.

2. Davies P M. Parabar Posy's Pocahontas Piparlo. Another stylish girl lovely head and expression, plenty of substance, could be a shade overweight, Topline in profile slight dip but is held on the move, which is neat and brisk.

3. Clementz & Gauthier, Madame & Madame. Foveaux Blues and Royals.

OB (3:1) 1. Creasey Mrs K. Ch Vittador Gold Dust for Leyeside. I gave this bitch her 1st CC, but today she had other ideas, very excitable was not for settling, she is when eventually standing a real model, love her markings correct head and eye, great topline & tail set, just a shame today was not her day.

2. Iven Ms H. Avrafastes Elo (bb74191nor) excellent temp, neat head cheeks could be fuller, short coat, little weak in front pasterns. shade long in loin.

VB (6:2) 1. Jones Mrs L. Ch Madincrowd Mercy Chant. well up to size 8 yr old lady.

Head on parallel planes, just lacking some under jaw, correct dark eye just a little round, nice forechest, good spring of rib, hocks bit too high, moved well.

2. Thwaite Mr J & Mr E A. Ch Ribblespride Ladytron another 8 yr old smaller stamp than 1, bit out of coat, ears set rather low, tad round in skull, lovely turn of stifle. Topline excellent moved with purpose.
