PUPPY DOG (1)

1st) FRAGARIALEA ELSANTA (Mr C & Mrs C Timmins) – Liver/Tan of great quality, Full of character, excellent head in proportion to his body, has width between his correctly set ears, almond shaped eyes coloured to match his deep rich Liver and tan coat, lips tight and super large teeth, his moderate neck flowed into his well laid shoulders, ribs were well sprung and he had a firm topline, Tail set on high and carried perfectly, his rear was well muscled which showed on his correct movement.

JUNIOR DOG (2)

1st) RIBBLESPRIDE KRUGER JW (Mrs P F Hughes)- Black/Tan with a nice head, correct parallel planes, flat skull and some width between his ears, which were floppy on the tips, almond shaped expressive eyes, he had a good depth of chest and ribbing extending back to close coupling, with a straight topline, correctly set tail curled over his back, moved out well.

2nd) MEA MIRACLES BEORN RAGNAR OF BARLEYDUST (IMP FIN) (Miss A D & Mrs D M Jones) -Black/Tan Larger male than 1st with a long muzzle, correct parallel planes and moderate stop, large upright ears set correctly, chest is developing and well laid shoulders, he has a correct tail set, moved out well.

GRADUATE DOG (0)

POST GRADUATE DOG (2,1A)

1st) LEYESIDE MISTER PINHAW AT DAWESLEAN (Mrs D J Dawes)- Deep rich Black/Tan, nice sized dog in good coat, excellent head proportions, and great ears, erect and correctly set, has good width and depth to chest, and a strong moderate neck into well-laid shoulders, straight topline ending with an excellent tail set, moved out well.

LIMIT DOG (2)

1st) SWANNDAL WALTER TYBALT (Dr E P J Cooper)- Black/Tan, narrow head, with correctly set ears, width to skull, tapering towards his dark almond eyes, long in neck in well-laid shoulders, he has depth to his chest and elbows firm against his ribs, straight topline to correctly set tail, stood on well-padded feet, rear was strong and correct on the move.

2nd) SKIPEST WINTER BLUES (Mr G & Mrs S Thomas) -Black/tan male, larger than 1st with a head in proportion to his body, correct ratio and moderate stop, correct set and carried ears, has good depth of chest, well-sprung ribs and a long loin, hocks well let down, moved quite well.

OPEN DOG (5,1A)1st) CH RIBBLESPRIDE CRAKEMOOR (Mr J & Mrs E A Thwaite)- Black/Tan dog, colour fading with age, nice shape to his head, correctly balanced, with correct ear set, dark almond expressive eyes, deep chest which has width, elbows nicely tucked in next to his ribs, strong moderate neck into well-laid shoulders, straight topline into a strong rear of well-turned stifle, tail correctly set and carried, movement was strong and direct.

2nd) UTTHANSHAVAN WOLF MOON MAN (Mrs W McBride)- Black/Tan with perfect markings and the classic thumb prints, correct head shape and in proportion to his body, excellent ears set wide on his head, Strong neck into well-laid shoulders, straight back with a correctly set tail, well-turned stifle which was a little weak on the rear movement, strode out well on the side gait.

VETERAN DOG (2)

1st) CH HENSON FAIREST LAD (Mrs C A Fairest)- Black/Tan large boy with a nice masculine head and excellent teeth, correct width of skull and set of ears, deep chest and strong moderate neck, into well-laid shoulders, correct ribbing to a strong rear, perfect tail set and carried correctly, moved out well.

2nd) WELSHMOOR BOBBYSOX (Mrs D J Dawes)- Black/Tan with such a lovely head of correct proportions, correct set ears, moderate neck and straight topline with a superb tail, has a good texture of coat, moved out well.

PUPPY BITCH (2)

1st) BARLEYDUST DARE TO DREAM (Miss A D & Mrs D M Jones)- 6 months with a rich Black/Tan colour, lovely head put together well and dark almond eyes, with the look of mischief, ears set is correct and strengthening, correctly put together although still raw, moderate neck, and chest is developing, ribbing is long and close coupling, good rear, excellent tail, moved well for a baby.

2nd) DROVERSROCK OBSIDIAN (Miss M L C Kenyon)- Liver /Tan with a nice head, moderate stop and correct parallel planes, excellent erect ears, moderate neck in well-laid shoulder, chest is developing, good ribbing and short coupling, nicely set rear.

JUNIOR BITCH (2,1A)

1st) RIBBLESPRIDE BOUDICCA (Miss M L C Kenyon)-Black/Tan with an ultra-feminine head, correctly proportioned with body, moderate stop and parallel planes and correctly set ears, some depth to chest, moderate neck, straight topline, high set tail curled over back, well bent stifles, moved out well.

GRADUATE BITCH (2,1A)

1st) RIBBLESPRIDE FREYA FENRIR (Mr I & Mrs J Clough & Erwin)- Rich Black/Tan with a feminine head, and outlook, dark expressive eyes and moderate stop, nice depth of chest, well ribbed and short coupled, strong rear, tail curled over back, moved out well.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (1,1A)

LIMIT BITCH (3)

1st) SKIPEST SUMMER BREEZE (Mrs C A Fairest)- Black/Tan with an excellent head, has width to the skull, ears correctly set, she has deep chest and strong moderate neck into well-laid shoulders, straight topline, hocks well let down, moved out well.

2nd) FOXTHYME TILLY (Mrs S Wiseman)- Black/Tan- smaller bitch, head in proportion with body, moderate stop and width to skull, correct set ears, almond expressive eyes, deep front and moderate neck into well-laid shoulders, nice coat texture, strong rear, moved out well.

3rd) MAHOGANY DAWN OF BARELYDUST (Miss A D & Mrs D M Jones)

OPEN BITCH (2)

1st) CH BARLEYDUST FANCY FOXTROT (Miss A D & Mrs D M Jones)- Black/Tan, with excellent head all in proportion, strong moderate neck, straight topline, well ribbed, tail set and carried correctly, enough bone, hocks well let down, moved out well

2nd) CH TAIGWYNION FREYA SADIE IN RONLEYDON (Mrs M Davis)- Rich Liver/Tan in perfect coat, with another lovely head in proportion to her body, large ears set correctly, great depth to her chest, straight topline, with an excellent tail. Moved out well.

VETERAN BITCH (6,2A)

Nice class of old ladies.

1st) CH RIBBLESPRIDE LADYTRON (Mr J & Mrs E A Thwaite)- Black/Tan balanced and in proportion, excellent head of correct moderate stop and parallel planes, correct ear set and carriage, good depth to her chest and a moderate neck, straight topline with correct ribbing extending to close coupled, tail set and carried correctly, small well-padded feet, moved correctly.

2nd) BLACK ROSE IN RONLEYDON (Mrs M Davis)-Black/Tan – old lady with the correct head, dark almond eyes set wide apart, deep chest, moderate stop, large ears set correctly, strong neck, straight topline, to a super tail set and carried correctly, correct rear, moved out well.
