Junior Handling
Class A. 6-11 Years (1,0)

1st McBride's Uttahnshavan Wolf Moon Man, Handler Matilda McBride.

A handsome dog in fine show condition, handled well by Matilda. He moved well with her and seemed to have a keen eye on her actions. He stood well on the table, although did seem more interested in the treats that his handler had for him. Promising duo.

Class B. 12-16 years

Class C. Special Award Special Yearling Dog or Bitch (7,2)

1st. Jones' Ch Barleydust Fancy Foxtrot. 22 months old black and tan girl, in excellent condition. Nice, rich tan, well set ears. Shorter in muzzle, but this does not detract from her famine presentation. Stood well on table, good topline. Moved well in tune with handler.
